Conclusions Drawn from Data:

Only 58.3% of this year's BAOM seniors met or exceeded the 75% criteria for success for Quantitative Reasoning. This percentage is 16.7% below the benchmark.

Changes to be Made Based on Data:

Similar to the Critical Reading/Thinking outcome, we need to analyze reasons why the BAOM seniors are not meeting the success criteria regarding their ability to solve problems that are quantitative in nature. Useful future considerations may result in adjustments to pedagogy, curriculum, and academic support.
