We gave the writing prompt as part of the Final exam again this year. Last year we considered giving it as a part of a Final project. We ran a pilot in the Fall semester, and found that students used it more as a review of the assignments than an overall reflection.

## **Changes to be Made Based on Data:**

We need to allow reflection time throughout the semester. Perhaps discussions on cultural differences will increase the numbers in the higher scores.
