Conclusions Drawn from Data:

Target is met. Any student who has not been able to pass this standardized test by semester 2 is removed from coursework until they pass. We have not had to eliminate any candidate from our program in the last 2 years based on non-passage. We provide CBEST preparation courses to any interested candidates.

Changes to be Made Based on Data:

No changes are necessary at this time.

Rubric Used:

All three sections of test must be passed (reading, writing and math), in order to pass the CBEST. Raw scores can range from 1-50, which are then converted to scaled scores ranging from 20-80. The passing scaled score on each section of the test is 41, and a minimum total score of 123 for all three sections must be achieved to pass.
