Community Ministries Use of Evidence of Student Learning

The 2012-2013 assessment of Community Ministries' student leadership was coupled with a change in department leadership. All of the student leadership was interviewed and assigned by the outgoing director of ten years, and trained and managed by the new director.

The program evaluation and assessment occurred at the end of the school year. Each student leader was asked to complete an informal, short answer evaluation of their leadership experience, as well as the formal assessment. In 2012-2013, a third question was added to the assessment to evaluate each leader's ability to articulate the connection between their Christian faith and service. In addition, a rubric was designed to assess the answers to this additional question. The rubric is based upon the AAC&U's Civic Engagement Value – Identity & Commitment Rubric.

The concerns of the former director about the level of spiritual leadership of the ministry leaders were well-founded. There was a shift in the 2012-2013 school year, as the four student directors overseeing each ministry area definitely exhibited a deep love for Christ, heart for service based on that love and belief in Christ, and helped to guide and shepherd their student leader cohort to that endeavor.

Evaluation of the data from both the evaluations and assessment resulted in a stronger emphasis on leadership training during the Student Ministries' leadership retreat at the beginning of the year, as well as during the weekly leader meetings.
