- † There is improvement in the general education program in terms of helping students develop values that are consistent with faith in Jesus Christ. In 2011 PLNU seniors were significantly below CCC&U peers. In 2014 the average is still below the CCC&U average, but is not statistically significant.
- † PLNU faculty show more interaction with students outside of class in helping students clarify personal beliefs. The mean response is significantly higher than CCC&U peers in both 2011 and 2014.
- † 77% of PLNU seniors agree or strongly agree that courses in their major have helped them think about how Christian values relate to their future profession.
- † 85.6% of PLNU seniors agree or strongly agree that professors take time to talk about their values and personal beliefs in class.

- † 81.9% of 2014 seniors agree or strongly agree that there is an environment on this campus that encourages students to develop values which reflect their faith in Jesus Christ.
- † 88.0% of 2014 seniors agree or strongly agree that this institution directly influenced their awareness of their own personal values.
- † There has been a significant improvement in seniors who attribute their experience at PLNU as shaping their values to be more consistent with a Christian world-view. In 2011 PLNU was significantly below the CCC&U comparison group, while in 2014 there is no longer a statistically significant difference.

- † 2014 PLNU seniors show significantly lower results than CCC&U comparison institutions in terms of reinforcement of values they have always held.
- † There is some improvement among seniors in terms of PLNU challenging students to think about issues from a Christian perspective. PLNU was significantly below CCC&U comparators in 2011, but in 2014 is still slightly below that group, but not statically significantly.
- † 85.0% of 2014 seniors agree or strongly agree that PLNU encourages students to worship God in meaningful ways.

- † 89.2% of 2014 seniors agreed or strongly agreed that they have a personally meaningful relationship with God.
- + 87.4% of 2014 seniors agreed or strongly agreed that they their relationship with God contributes to their sense of well-being.
- † 84.3% of 2014 seniors agreed or strongly agreed that their relationship with God affects their day to day life.
- + 87.3% of 2014 seniors agreed or strongly agreed that they would hold fast to their Christian convictions against opposition.
- + 91.6% of 2014 seniors agreed or strongly agreed that they need to be open to consideration of new insights and truths about their faith.
- † Percentages on these five questions show no statistically significant differences from the CCC&U comparison group and also show neglible changes from the 2011 results.
