Motion to call the question to end discussion **passes 66x18**

Vote on proposal I. - **failed** 66x20

ILO will be left as is: "Students will serve locally and/or globally in vocational and social settings"

Proposal 2: adopted 77x8

Removed: Students will be able to comprehend, interpret, and analyze texts

Proposal 3: adopted 82x2

Removed : Problem Solving: Students will be able to use knowledge and understanding in order to identify and address problems

Proposal 4: adopted 82x1

Removed : Creative Synthesis: Students will be able to create original works and thoughts based on knowledge, material, and imagination.

Proposal 5:

"Develop an understanding of self that fosters personal wellbeing." **Adopted:** 66x7 with 5 abstain

Motion and 2nd to amend Proposal to "Develop an understanding that fosters human well-being."

Friendly amendment: - "Demonstrate an understanding that fosters human well-being"

Motion to call the question to stop discussion passed 68x7

Vote on motion with friendly amendment: "Demonstrate an understand that fosters human well-being." Failed

Motion to call the question to stop discussion – passed 61x19

Vote on the original proposal: **Adopted:** 66x7 with 5 abstain

Motion and 2nd to reconsider and bring it back to committee Fails 46x24

Proposal 6

Change "Understand and appreciate others in the context of their diverse backgrounds" To: "Understand and appreciate diverse forms of artistic expression."

Motion and 2nd to change the word in the original version from "Their" to "Our"

Friendly amendment to strike the word "their" altogether in the amended wording.

Call the question to stop talking: **Passed** 66x1

Vote on amendment to remove the word "their"

"Understand and appreciate others in the context of diverse backgrounds." Adopted 63x6

Proposal 7 D is chosen and passes with 36 votes

Proposal 7D **adopted**: 61x6

Students will demonstrate an understanding of Christian Scripture, Tradition, and Ethics, including engagement in acts of devotion and works of mercy.

Proposal 8 adopted: 67x1

Removed: Students will articulate a sense of vocational calling, drawing connections between their educational training and their responsibilities in the world.
