

- Undergraduate enrollment in the HPS department has remained steady over the past 7 years with the exception of Fall 2010 when there was a spike in enrollment.
- The HPS department currently makes up 4.0% of total PLNU undergraduate enrollment.
- The HPS department's share of undergraduate enrollment has dropped.
- Political Science is the largest major within the department. The opening of the International Studies major in 2004 has mitigated the declines in the History and Social Science majors.
- The HPS department had a period (Fall 2005 through Fall 2009) where they had a higher number of double majors. That has dropped in recent years.
- History minors make up 2.9% of PLNU's total minors.
- Enrollment in the History minor dropped from Fall 2011 to Fall 2013. However, the Fall 2014 number of History minors is double that of the previous year.
