

Curriculum Map - Liberal Studies: Teacher Education

The Liberal Studies: Teacher Education program includes a series of courses designed to meet California State Standards for Multiple Subject, Single Subject or Education Specialist Preliminary teaching credentials along a traditional undergraduate pathway. The content and standards of these credential courses are subject to CTC accreditation cycles and the foundation upon which the Liberal Studies: Teacher Education program is built. Table One displays the seven Liberal Studies: Teacher Education PLOs. Table Two displays the seven PLOs and the courses in which each is Introduced (I), Developed (D), or Mastered (M) as candidates work toward program completion and their degree.

Table 1: Teaching, M.A. Program Learning Outcomes

PLO 1a - Candidates will demonstrate effective oral presentation skills, one-on-one and with groups.
