We also enjoyed considerable success in Cross Examination Debate Association (CEDA) style prior to joining NPDA.

2007 PLNU students Griffith Vertican & Tim Kamermayer won the National Championship Tournament, going undefeated in 8 preliminary rounds and through 7 elimination rounds.

## **PLNU Debate Teams National Ranking (1996-2017)**

The following is a summary table tabulating how PLNU debaters faired against the nation's best college and university debate teams across the country over time. The table tracks the top teams in the year-end comparison rankings over time in the current format of National Parliamentary Debate Association (NPDA) debate. The NPDA has collected data for over 20 years, coincidentally dating back to the first year of PLNU's participation in the NPDA format. Each year since 1996 they have listed the top 20 NPDA debate programs based on the rankings for all participating colleges and universities throughout the country, calculated from how each college did in their top four tournaments of the year. The spreadsheet lists each of the top 20 colleges for each year during that span, and for each year awarded points based upon the school's placement , if any, in that year's top 20 rankings (1<sup>st</sup> Place = 20 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 19 points, . . . 20<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point).

PLNU is ranked first out of all the colleges and universities competing during this span of the last 22 years in NPDA debate. It is estimated that around 500 or more colleges and universities throughout the nation, and some international universities, have competed in NPDA debate during this time span, more than any other format of intercollegiate debate. The chart below gives the full data of all college and universities to receive any points for placing in the year end top 20 sweepstakes awards nationwide. Remember, hundreds of colleges competing each year do not even get ranked in the annual ranking of the top 20, so many fine programs may not be shown in this list below.
