WRI 110 (5) College Composition: Writing and Research—GE

A comprehensive first-year composition experience in reading, writing, and critical thinking, centered on the essay. The course emphasizes the processes of writing thesis-based manuscripts as an evolving product, with attention to sentence-level conventions and coherence among well-developed paragraphs. Library research and writing the source-based essay are major components of the course.

WRI 115 (3) College Composition: Writing—GE

A first-year composition experience in reading, writing, and critical thinking, centered on the essay. The course emphasizes the processes of writing thesis-based manuscripts as an evolving product, with attention to sentence-level conventions and coherence among well-developed paragraphs.

WRI 116 (2) College Composition: Research—GE

A first-year composition experience in reading, writing and critical thinking, centered on the essay. The course emphasizes the processes of writing as well as the manuscript as an evolving product. Library research and writing the source-based essay are the major thrusts of the course.
