Conclusions Drawn from Data:

The percentages for proficiency are lower than seen with PLNU traditional BSN students. A straight comparison between the two groups is not appropriate in that it does not take into consideration the unique characteristics of an adult learner versus a traditional student (e.g. - prior learning, culture and diversity considerations, etc.)

Changes to be Made Based on Data:

The RN-BSN program is a young program, and not enough data exists to know if the current criteria for success are an appropriate benchmark. The School of Nursing Program Assessment Committee will review data collected during SU18, FA18, and SP19 in order to determine an appropriate benchmark and plan for future assessment. Results may be lower due to a change in testing procedures (an imposed time limit).
