NSG 150 – Caring Faithfully: An Introduction to Nursing (2 units)

Course Description – The role of the nurse is introduced within the context of Christian service and caring. Major concepts include: therapeutic communication, clinical practice (i.e. California Nurse Practice Act), nursing as a vocational calling and service to others.

NSG 470 – Leading Faithfully: A Synthesis and Transition to Professional Nursing Practice (3 units)

Course Description: Nursing theory as it is related to trends and issues in healthcare management including analysis and synthesis of the professional nurse role. Focus is on leadership theories and styles within multiple healthcare environments. Content includes nursing theory as it relates to leadership/management principles, career development, communication, leading change, problem solving/decision making, coordinating client care, conflict management, interdisciplinary team approaches, cultural diversity, managing personal and organizational resources, legal, ethical and political influences on transition to the professional nurse role.

NSG 480 – Nursing Capstone (1 unit)

Course Description: Analysis and synthesis of transitional concepts, topics and issues for students assuming a professional nursing role.

NSG 481 – Nursing Capstone Practicum (3 units)

Course Description: Application of nursing skills in client care settings with opportunity to provide nursing care to persons with complex health problems. Emphasis is on critical thinking, clinical decision making and independent judgment in areas of client nursing care as well as management of nursing services. Includes collaboration with health team members and implementation of organizational skills.
