Analysis: In 2018, Social Work seniors completed ETS testing to help assess PLNU-identified core competencies. The results were returned in aggregate with social work and students for other majors in the department in the same report. Overall ETS results were not favorable in comparison with prior years. Given the results on the CSWE measures, more exploration of the differing results is warranted.

Action: Request dis-aggregated ETS results to determine Social Work Program performance.
