

Summer Music Team Data Summer 2011

There were 15 respondents to the 2011 survey. This data was gathered in the midst of updating learning outcomes.

Did you feel you grew musically? If so, how? If not, why?

Only four people indicated that they had not grown musically. Of these four, one member was not involved in the music but still learned about lyrics. So, the overwhelming majority of the members grew musically.

Connected with: Students will demonstrate the ability to effectively lead worship.

Was there a time when you were clearly asked to be a servant, and if so, what was your reaction? Joy? Annoyance? Something else?

Eight of the members indicated that their reaction was Joyful, and two more were initially hesitant and then joyful. Two members indicated that their reaction varied with the situation between joyful and annoyed. One indicated that it gave a sense of purpose. Only one member indicated that their reaction was apathetic and one responded that the question was not applicable. So, the vast majority reacted joyfully.

Connected with: Students will maintain a positive attitude in the varied job roles they are given each day.

How did you prepare personally for the worship services? In addition, what would you have liked to do to best prepare had you had more control over your schedule?

Eight members responded that they prepared by prayer and daily devotions. Four members gave technical responses along the lines of knowing the songs and the order. One responded with both of these. One member each wrote about creating media and went through scripture, put together scripts, and reflected on the theme of the service. So, most members prepared in expected ways.

Connected with: Students will demonstrate the ability to function effectively as members of a worship team and demonstrate the ability to effectively lead worship.

What was something that was difficult to deal with (e.g., a personality, a task)?

Two members did not indicate having had any difficult situations. Five had differences of opinion or personality clashes within their team members. Three had difficulty connecting with campers. The single member responses were “being tired,” “insecurity,” “sadness and emotional moments,” “equipment issues,” and “trying to get the most out of ‘cabin time.’”

Connected with: Students will demonstrate the ability to function effectively as members of a worship team.

Did you make time each day to spend in prayer and the word? If so, what did that look like? If not, is that a regret or do you feel the absence of it hindered you in any way?

Thirteen of the members engaged in some combination of devotionals, daily prayer, journaling, and scripture reading. One of these also indicated spiritual discussions with team members. For one member this was done through incorporating scripture and prayer into music sets. Only one member gave a negative response.

Connected with: *Students will be able to articulate their faith in Jesus and what it means to be a Christian*
