NEW Business

1. LEAP & ROTC email message from Kim Bogan (Kathy)

- Mark shared with Committee for informal discussion
- Kathy recommends policy specifically state LEAP students are on academic probation and therefore not able to participate in athletics, ROTC.
- Mark to draft narrative to revise/update policy and email to Committee for electronic vote – will present to faculty along with other LEAP policy
 - NOTE: per Kathy, electronic vote on Oct. 7 was unanimous – policy will go before full faculty for vote

2. Identity Fraud Statement

- Kathy distributed to Committee “Academic Honesty” policy as stated in Student Handbook
- Kathy reviewed Dave Phillips’ statement regarding identity fraud is a criminal offense and stated identity fraud is one step further from “Falsification”
- Committee discussed where to insert with the Academic Honesty policy
- Per Kathy, will go before full faculty for vote since serious consequences
- Discussion to continue next APC meeting

OLD Business

1. What constitutes a certificate?

- per Kathy, APC role is to look more at a traditional student (undergraduate)
- PLNU has no guidelines for certificates but has for minors – distinguish between the 2 is necessary
- Certificate more of a professional nature to add on to an existing degree
- In general, certificates = approximately 15 units
 - Need to determine minimum amount of units as well as maximum

- Need to distinguish relationship between degree program and certificate program
- “credit bearing courses” – PLNU expectation of program
