Doctoral Dissertation: "Emotional Intelligence and Religious Orientation as Predictors of Abortion Decision-Making." This study examined whether women who planned to carry an unplanned pregnancy to term differed from those who planned to abort on the dimensions of Emotional Intelligence and Religious Orientation. The assessment instruments utilized were the BarOn Emotional Quotient Inventory and the Religious Orientation Scale-Revised. A sample of 30 women, 15 for each of two comparison groups, was sought from a Crisis Pregnancy Clinic in Riverside, California. Dissertation was defended 2-00.
