COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides an understanding of fundamental principles governing production, distribution, and exchange of wealth with emphasis on current economic problems, for business majors. Topics include national income determination, fiscal policy, monetary policy,, money & banking, economic stabilization policy, international linkages, balance of payment issues, exchange rate determination and international trade.
